





# DAAD In-Country/In-Region Scholarship Programme Sub-Sahara Africa



Supports Intra-African mobility – degree mobility for Master and PhD

At present, **30 institutions of Higher education** active in the programme

- **Eastern Africa** > 11 partner institutions
- Southern Africa → 8 partner institutions + National Research Foundation (NRF)
- West and Central Africa → 11 partner institutions

On average the DAAD awards up to **300 new scholarships** each year in this programme
